The purpose of this document is to let you know about our policies and procedures IN ADVANCE, so you can make the best possible use of our event and our services. We have developed these policies and procedures to ensure our EARTHfest event will be as safe and successful as possible. Of course, not all situations will be covered in this guide or may need special consideration by management. - **ANIMALS**

For the safety and comfort of all our visitors, animals are not permitted in the Event Area except Guide, Signal or Service dogs (as defined by law) are allowed in the Event Area. All sanitary needs for animals are the responsibility of the Owner / Handler.

- **BOOTH**

There is a \$25.00 fee for Vendor booths (Food, Jewelry, Clothes, etc). Informational or Demonstrational Booths are **FREE**. **Booth Applications must be paid at the time your application is submitted**

Application deadline is, April 19, 2019 by the close of business (5pm).

- **BULK TRASH**

This is a **"ZERO WASTE"** Event. All items must be Recyclable, Compostable or Biodegradable. Vendors need to separate Recycled goods, Compostable and Biodegradable goods into the designated bin, all bins are clearly marked. **Trash Bins will not be provided.**

- **FOOD**

For public health reasons, restrooms, concession stands and / or facility kitchens may not be used as vendor clean-up areas. Vendors are responsible for complying with all Habematolel Pomo of Upper Lake's Environmental Department.

- Biodegradable or compostable items can be purchased for a fee through Habematolel Pomo of Upper Lake Tribe. (while supplies last, inventory is limited)
- Habematolel Pomo of Upper Lake is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- Habematolel Pomo of Upper Lake will not supply any materials or financial support for items you wish to sell.

PARTICIPANT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

- I will supply my own tables, chairs, shade awnings or these items can be rented for a fee. (All space size is 8foot x 8foot)
- I will clean up my booth area at the end of the EARTHfest Event.
- I have received Event Rules and Regulations and will abide by all rules stated in this document.
- Failure to comply with rules will lead to closure of booth & Vendor will be asked to leave without a refund.
